



Expansion Plans for DCH are in the Works

Expansion plans for Durham Christian Homes (DCH) are moving along. Our plans to become a provider of 'Long-Term Care' are coming closer to reality.

As many of our members already know, our conditional agreement to purchase two long-term care (LTC) facilities in Bowmanville: Strathaven and Marnwood, is expected to be finalized by the end of 2010.

Currently we await approval from Ontario's Ministry of Health & Long-term Care for the transfer of bed operating licences. With the purchase of these two existing LTC facilities in Bowmanville, DCH plans to do some upgrading with the older facilities and move a portion of the bed licences to our Whitby location. Thus, allowing us the beds necessary to build our much anticipated 'Glen Hill Terrace' LTC facility beside our existing independent living towers.

Along with our LTC building plans we are also planning the construction of a third tower for independent living - 'Heritage Place'. Both these buildings will be built at the same time beside our current towers.

It is our goal to provide a continuum of care for our residents. That is, to be a provider of both independent living and long-term care housing and services for seniors. With the provision of added levels of care, the transition from independent living into LTC should make it possible for residents to remain under the 'umbrella of DCH', close to their DCH community, a spouse or familiar friends.

As we move forward with these expansion plans our DCH Board, staff, and community continues to seek your prayerful support and God's guiding hand.



Parking Lot Now Complete!

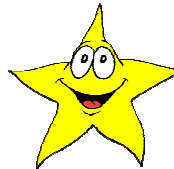


Our limited parking issues at DCH have been resolved. A back parking lot was constructed and paved this summer and is now complete.
