Long-Term Care Plans Become Real

The BIG NEWS from Durham Christian Homes this month is the much anticipated purchase of the Strathaven and Marnwood LTC and

Retirement Homes in Bowmanville. The combined LTC room capacity for both facilities is 259 beds, plus 85 assisted-living retirement rooms between the two facilities. We officially became the new owners of these homes on March 1st!

Thus, we have entered the realm of Long-Term Care (LTC) management! With the approval from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) and the official LTC operator's license in our possession, we now qualify to receive the first phase of loan financing from Infrastructure Ontario. We will take on approximately 350 full-time and part-time employees between the two Bowmanville buildings.

This approval brings us one step closer to the next phase of our plan, which is to build Glen Hill Terrace (an LTC building) and Heritage Place (a Life Lease building) on our Whitby property. Praise be to God!



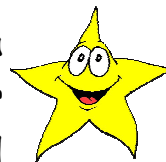

Mr. Zock has worked with organizations similar to ours and has a great deal of experience in dealing with life leases. DCH plans to host a Heritage Place/Life Lease Information session sometime this Spring. Stay tuned for details of the date and time for this meeting. At this information session we hope to present some preliminary designs of the proposed units and information on Life Leases.
