Position Summary:

The Maintenance Worker will work under the guidance of the Facilities Manager to perform various skilled and semi-skilled tasks in maintenance as assigned.

The Maintenance Worker is required to perform their duties in a manner consistent with the core values and employee guiding principles, ensure resident safety, and demonstrate customer service excellence.

Tasks and Responsibilities:

Under the guidance of the Facilities Manager, the successful candidate's duties and responsibilities include:

- Assisting with general maintenance and repairs in public and in-suite areas
- Assisting with the completion of scheduled preventative maintenance duties
- Ensuring the grounds are cleaned and maintained
- Maintain public areas inside our buildings
- Perform routine maintenance jobs and repairs
- Provide exceptional customer service to our residents

Qualifications:

As this position has been made possible by the **Canada Summer Jobs Program** through the Government of Canada, all applicants must meet the following conditions:

1. Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period;
2. Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
3. Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada.
4. Preference to those enrolled in a skilled trade, building maintenance or similar program

Duration, Hours of Work and Salary
