Position Summary:

The Handyperson will work alongside the Maintenance Caretaker to ensure timely completion of necessary work orders as requested by residents. This position is expected to maintain good working relations with the residents and to respond to requests within their area of responsibility for both Providence Place and Tekoa Manor.

Tasks and Responsibilities:

Under the guidance of the Maintenance Caretaker, the successful candidate's duties and responsibilities include:

- Assisting with general maintenance and repairs in public and in-suite areas
- Assisting with the completion of scheduled preventative maintenance duties
- Ensuring the grounds are cleaned and maintained
- Maintain public areas inside our buildings
- Perform routine maintenance jobs and repairs
- Provide exceptional customer service to our residents

Qualifications:

As this position has been made possible by the **Canada Summer Jobs Program** through the Government of Canada, all applicants must meet the following conditions:

1. Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period;

2. Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act

3. Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada.

4. Enrollment in a skilled trade or building maintenance program preferred

Duration, Hours of Work and Salary
