



Tekoa Manor and Providence Place Covid-19 update

January 5, 2021

On December 26th, Durham Region, along with the rest of Ontario, entered into a Province-wide Shutdown. This was done to help stop the trend of high COVID-19 transmission in communities, preserve health system capacity, and safeguard vulnerable populations and those who care for them.

In accordance with the Ministry of Health, we are reminding all residents of Durham Christian Homes that **wearing a non-medical face mask or face covering is mandatory in all common areas** (e.g., lobbies, elevators, hallways, laundry rooms, meeting rooms, and other common-use facilities). Individuals not wearing a mask may be asked to depart from the premises. We know that it has not been easy to suspend activity and fellowship, and we are praying for the Lord to speed the end of this pandemic.
